Tanja Poutainen-Rinne is a former professional athlete in alpine skiing. She finished her career at the age of 34 in 2014 after Sochi Olympics. Tanja raced in 5 Winter Olympic Games (1998, 2002, 2006, 2010 & 2014) and achieved one silver medal in Torino 2006. During her 17 years in the Alpine Skiing World Cup she won the discipline title 3 times.
